Once you complete the process, Air Canada will send you a confirmation email with your updated booking status.

3. Visit the Airport Ticket Counter

If you've already reached the airport and need to cancel on short notice, visit the Air Canada ticket desk.

Bring your passport, booking confirmation, and ID -- an agent will handle your request and inform you of refund options.

Like many major Airways, Air Canada allows you to cancel a flight within 24 hours of booking for a full refund -- no fees, no questions asked.

Conditions:

- The booking must have been made at least 7 days before departure.
- The 24-hour window applies to tickets booked directly via Air Canada's website, office, or customer service line.

Here are a few smart ways to minimize or eliminate fees when canceling a Air Canada flight:

1. Cancel within 24 hours of booking (best for full refunds).

4. Cancel early -- the closer you get to departure, the higher the potential fees.

Absolutely. If you don't want to lose your booking, Air Canada allows date changes and rebookings for most fare types. In many cases, changing your flight date can be cheaper than canceling it entirely.

To reschedule:

- Provide your booking reference and preferred new travel date.
- Pay only the fare difference (if applicable) -- not full cancellation fees.

When canceling, you'll generally receive your refund through your original payment method within 720 business days.

Refunds are processed based on your fare type:

- Refundable tickets: Full refund to the original payment method.
 - Non-refundable tickets: Eligible for travel credits or partial refunds (taxes, fees).
 - Award tickets (miles): Miles are returned to your account, minus service fees.
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- Always double-check your fare rules before canceling.
 - If you booked via a travel agency, contact them directly.
 - Keep a copy of your cancellation confirmation email for records.
 - Refund processing time can vary based on your bank or payment method.
 - If you experience flight disruptions, Air Canada may issue waivers to skip cancellation fees --
